Clark Harrison, shot by an enemy sniper in World War II and paralyzed from the waist down, was determined to prove that a paraplegic could accomplish what he set out to do. He was a REALTOR®, Chairman of the DeKalb County Board of Commissioners, founder of Fidelity National Bank, and along with James Shepherd, founder of Shepherd Spinal Center. Along with these business ventures, he wanted to prove that a paraplegic could accomplish physical activities, also. He swam a mile a day, and actively pursued whitewater canoeing, hot air ballooning, scuba diving, hunting, fishing, horseback riding, and flying his own plane. This award, named after Clark Harrison, recognizes community service.
