



DeKalb REALTORS® Hall of Fame Nomination Information

The DeKalb REALTORS® Hall of Fame, established in 2014, honors DeKalb REALTORS® who have made extraordinary and distinguished contributions to the real estate profession and markets in Georgia over a period of at least 20 years. Hall of Fame induction is considered our highest career honor. Honorees will be recognized each year during the DeKalb REALTORS® December Annual Business Meeting/ Installation of Officers Meeting, and via a perpetual memorial plaque at the DeKalb REALTORS® Headquarters Building.

Method of Selection

1. Nomination must be by a member of the Association. Nominations must be received by the DeKalb Association of REALTORS® no later than midnight, **September 1** each year.
2. The DeKalb REALTORS® Historical Committee will review Hall of Fame nominations and select the honorees from the applications submitted. The Historical Committee also may choose to induct members who have made outstanding contributions to the Association who have not been nominated by a specific individual. Using the criteria below as a guideline, selection into the Hall of Fame will be by majority agreement of those members of the committee present at the selection meeting.
3. In the initial selection year of the DeKalb REALTOR® Hall of Fame, up to 15 charter inductees may be selected; in each award year that follows, the selection committee shall decide the number of inductees. Committee may opt not to honor any individuals in any given year if no qualified candidates are nominated.
4. The Historical Committee feels the honor seeks the candidate; any campaigning or contact with any committee member is strongly discouraged. Lobbying for the nominee is improper and may disqualify the nominee, at the discretion of the selection committee.

Criteria for Selection

1. Nominee must have had at least 20 years of service as a member of the DeKalb Association of REALTORS®.
2. Nominee may be living or deceased.
3. Nominee must have contributed significantly to the real estate profession in the State of Georgia.
4. While not required, additional consideration is given for state and national service. Nominee must have been involved in the DeKalb Association, and must be/have been recognized as a leader in the real estate profession in his or her community.
5. An individual may be nominated more than once; however, a new form must be submitted each year a person is nominated. Information will not be carried over from one year to the next.
6. All Hall of Fame nomination forms are kept strictly confidential. All materials submitted become the property of the DeKalb Association of REALTORS® and will not be returned.
8. Any DeKalb Association member in good standing may nominate an individual.
