More Efficient Process, Saves Time and Money


Over 200 residents, builders, architects, and engineers have saved time and money by submitting their plans electronically using ePlans.

What is ePlans?

ePlans is a free program that enables applicants for Building Permits, Land Development Permits, or Zoning applications to submit their plans electronically from the comfort of your home or office.

How does ePlans work?

The ePlans process begins by (1) <u>Submitting</u> an application for a Land Development Permit, Building Permit, or Zoning application in person to the Department of Planning and Sustainability, (2) <u>Informing</u> the intake staff you will be submitting plans through ePlans (3) <u>Paying</u> all required fees (4) <u>Submitting</u> plans electronically, (5) <u>Receiving</u> an electronic notification once the plans have been reviewed, and (6) <u>Uploading</u> revised drawings to ePlans if necessary. Constant communication is maintained between the customer and DeKalb County.
